



#### **TUITION FEES: UNDERGRADUATE**

### £6,165 - £9,250 per year 2019 entry

(Check individual universities and courses for details)

### **Oxford Brookes University**

£9,250 per year

(For undergraduate degrees taught at Oxford Brookes)



## TUITION FEES: FOUNDATION DEGREES

Foundation degree costs may differ to onsite degrees

### **Oxford Brookes University**


£7,395 per year / £9,250 for top up year

(Foundation/Bachelor degrees taught in Further Education Colleges)



On average, what percentage of university tuition fees is spent on teaching?










## HOW WILL STUDENTS PAY FOR IT ALL?







### **TUITION FEE LOAN**

### Students are entitled to: £6,165 - £9,250 per year for 2019 entry

#### Note:

- Tuition fees are available to all those eligible
- Fees are paid directly to the university

#### MAXIMUM MAINTENANCE LOAN











# 30 Years

# How long do you have to pay your student finance loan back?

Note: After this time the loan is then wiped





#### Both loans are combined in to one amount

Repayments start:

The **April** after the course finishes

When the student is earning at least £25,000 per year

**HMRC** 

Interest Rates Loan wiped after 30 years



# Once you are earning over:

£25,000

When do you have to start paying back your student loan?

Or the April after your course finishes






### Repay tuition fee and maintenance loan at:

### 9% of income over £25,000

Salary	Repayment	Equivalent To
£25,000	£0 per month	O Coffees a week
£27,000	£15 per month	1 Coffee a week
£30,000	£37 per month	3 Coffees a week




#### STUDENT BANK ACCOUNTS

- Don't choose the bank with the best freebie
- Look for the differences between 'guaranteed' and 'up to' overdrafts
- Don't spend more than your overdraft limit
- Don't get a student bank account if you don't need one!
